Dear Parishioners and Visitors,

This week I would like to mention Mass in the “Extraordinary Form” (Traditional Latin Mass) at St Mary’s Cathedral, Sydney. Following the provisions of the Papal document “Summorum Pontificum”, issued by Pope Benedict XVI in 2007, Mass may be celebrated in parishes according to the Roman Missal of 1962 when there is a stable group of people attached to the traditional liturgical rites which preceded the post Vatican II liturgical reforms.

Such a stable group exists at St Mary’s Cathedral Parish, having its origins in the previous celebration of the Traditional Latin Mass at the University Chapel of the Resurrection which used to stand on City Road.

Archbishop Anthony, desiring that the pastoral provisions of “Summorum Pontificum” should be applied with fitting generosity, has asked me to continue to arrange for the celebration of Mass in the Extraordinary Form regularly in the Cathedral, although the principal location for the traditional Latin rites is the Personal Parish for the Extraordinary Form, located at the Maternal Heart Church at Lewisham.

For the most part, the liturgical life of the Cathedral is conducted in the Ordinary Form of the Roman Rite, that is, according to the rites as reformed in the years after the Second Vatican Council. However, Low Mass in the Extraordinary Form is celebrated in the Cathedral each Sunday at 12.15pm, usually in Our Lady’s Chapel. All Catholics are, naturally, welcome to attend the Extraordinary Form Mass, with a reminder that Holy Communion may only be received according to the traditional rite, that is, kneeling and on the tongue, at that Mass.

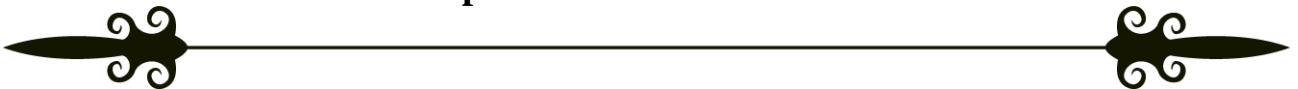
**First Reading Is 6:1-8**

**A reading from the prophet Isaiah**

*Here am I! Send me.*

In the year of King Uzziah's death I saw the Lord seated on a high throne; his train filled the sanctuary; above him stood seraphs, each one with six wings. And they cried out to one another in this way, 'Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts. His glory fills the whole earth.' The foundations of the threshold shook with the voice of the one who cried out, and the Temple was filled with smoke. I said: 'What a wretched state I am in! I am lost, for I am a man of unclean lips and I live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have looked at the King, the Lord of hosts.' Then one of the seraphs flew to me, holding in his hand a live coal which he had taken from the altar with a pair of tongs. With this he touched my mouth and said: 'See now, this has touched your lips, your sin is taken away, your iniquity is purged.' Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying: 'Whom shall I send? Who will be our messenger?' I answered, 'Here I am, send me.'

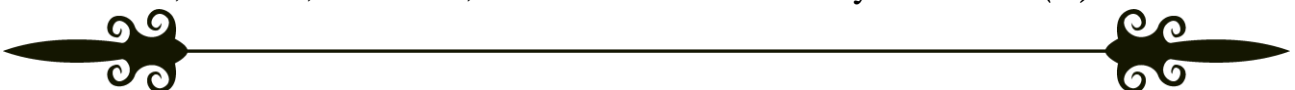

**Second Reading 1 Cor 15:1-11**

**A reading from the letter of St Paul to the Corinthians**

*I preach what they preach, and this is what you believe.*

Brothers, I want to remind you of the gospel I preached to you, the gospel that you received and in which you are firmly established; because the gospel will save you only if you keep believing exactly what I preached to you – believing anything else will not lead to anything.

Well then, in the first place, I taught you what I had been taught myself, namely that Christ died for our sins, in accordance with the scriptures; that he was buried; and that he was raised to life on the third day, in accordance with the scriptures; that he appeared first to Cephas and secondly to the Twelve. Next he appeared to more than five hundred of the brothers at the same time, most of whom are still alive, though some have died; then he appeared to James, and then to all the apostles; and last of all he appeared to me too; it was as though I was born when no one expected it.

I am the least of the apostles; in fact, since I persecuted the Church of God, I hardly deserve the name apostle; but by God's grace that is what I am, and the grace that he gave me has not been fruitless. On the contrary, I, or rather the grace of God that is with me, have worked harder than any of the others; but what matters is that I preach what they preach, and this is what you all believed.

**Gospel Lk 5:1-11**

**A reading from the holy Gospel according to Luke**

*They left everything and followed him.*


Jesus was standing one day by the lake of Gennesaret, with the crowd pressing round him listening to the word of God, when he caught sight of two boats close to the bank. The fishermen had gone out of them and were washing their nets. He got into one of the boats – it was Simon’s – and asked him to put out a little from the shore. Then he sat down and taught the crowds from the boat.

When he had finished speaking he said to Simon, ‘Put out into deep water and pay out your nets for a catch.’ ‘Master,’ Simon replied ‘we worked hard all night long and caught nothing, but if you say so, I will pay out the nets.’ And when they had done this they netted such a huge number of fish that their nets began to tear, so they signalled to their companions in the other boat to come and help them; when these came, they filled the two boats to sinking point.


When Simon Peter saw this he fell at the knees of Jesus saying, ‘Leave me Lord; I am a sinful man.’ For he and all his companions were completely overcome by the catch they had made; so also were James and John, sons of Zebedee, who were Simon’s partners. But Jesus said to Simon, ‘Do not be afraid; from now on it is men you will catch.’ Then, bringing their boats back to land, they left everything and followed him.

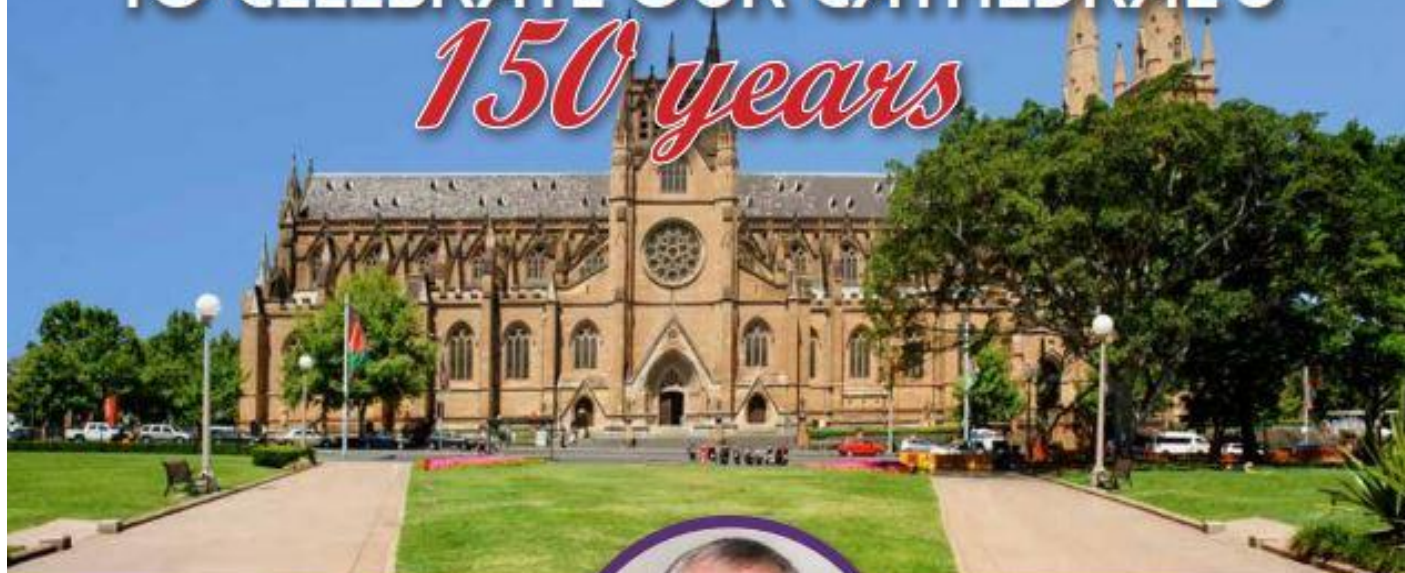
