

WORD FROM THE DEAN



Dear Friends,

This printed edition of the Cathedral weekly bulletin is another step in the return to "normal." It is a bit dangerous: it might spread germs so you mustn't hand it from person to person or leave it lying around once you've handled it, but either take it home (my preferred option) or place it in the waste bins provided on your way out.

It has been nice to see rather more people coming to Mass in the last two or three weeks, and it was especially good to see such numbers here on Ash Wednesday. I think it's a bit like the new life of springtime (even though its summer). What a blessing to live in Australia, and especially in Sydney!

A number of COVID-related precautions remain in place, including:

- Holy water is still not placed in the stoups, but you can obtain some from the sacristy outside of Mass times if you have a suitable container, and the rite of Blessing and Sprinkling of Holy Water takes place at the 10.30am mass on the 1st Sunday of each month.
- Holy Communion is still recommended to be receive in the hand rather than on the tongue at this time, in the ordinary Masses.
- Social distancing: please only sit close to people who are part of your own household, and maintain your distance when moving around the cathedral
- No physical contact during the sign of peace, if given.
- People in the congregation who want to sing must wear a mask.
- Please continue to use hand sanitiser, which is readily available in the cathedral.

As it is Lent, I can highly recommend the booklet "A Lenten Companion" prepared by the Archdiocese's "Centre for Evangelisation", available near the doors. It has some weekly Lenten reflections and other prayers for you to use at home.


Anyway, I don't want to burden you with too many words in this first edition of the "new" newsletter. God bless.

The St Vincent de Paul Society


is an International Catholic voluntary organisation of lay people.
