

WORD FROM THE DEAN



Dear Cathedral Parishioners and Visitors,

March is an interesting month, as the summer begins to fade, the quality of the light changes, and the first hints of coolness begin to take hold. (Soon enough those nuisance London Plane trees on St Mary's Road outside the cathedral will begin to drop their leaves by the tonne.) March is interesting liturgically, too, and I want to draw to your attention some upcoming commemorations and feasts:

- 8th March is the Anniversary of death of Archbishop Michael Kelly, 4th Archbishop of Sydney, in 1940, "Michael the Builder" who completed the construction of the nave and crypt of St Mary's.
- 13th March is the Anniversary of election of Pope Francis, in 2013.
- 16th March is the Anniversary of death in 1877 of Archbishop John Bede Polding, our first Archbishop, and also the Anniversary of death of sixth Archbishop, Sir James Darcy Cardinal Freeman in 1991.
- 17th March is St Patrick's Day, which has always been so important for the Church in Australia.
- 19th March is St Joseph's Day, which takes on added significance during this current "Year of St Joseph" proclaimed by Pope Francis.
- 25th March is the wonderful feast of the Annunciation of the Lord.

And our season of Lent continues throughout March this year, with all the spiritual opportunities and challenges which Lent provides.

Check the notices and liturgy timetable for things to do here, and let's enjoy March together at St Mary's Cathedral!
