WORD FROM THE DEAN



Dear Cathedral Parishioners and Visitors,

Later this year, in October, we will commemorate 200 years since the foundation of the first St Mary's Cathedral on this site. Just in this past week the rainy windy weather has done a little damage to some of the last remaining stonework from old St Mary's, which stands outside the eastern side of the present cathedral. I am reminded of the words of Psalm 127, "Unless the Lord builds the house, in vain do its builders labour." Appropriate stabilisation work is in hand to preserve this visible testimonial to the vision and tenacity of the first Catholic chaplain to the colony, Fr J.J. Therry, and those pioneer Catholics he served.

This Lent seems to be flying past: next Sunday will be Palm Sunday already. Last year, due to the pandemic, we were restricted to a total of ten people at Mass on Palm Sunday. Instead of our usual crowded outdoor Blessing of Palms and Procession, the cathedral clergy processed from the Irish Saints Chapel to the main altar. Thanks be to God we are able to have a full outdoor Procession this year of up to 500 people, with Covid-safe procedures. This will commence at 10.15am next Sunday, 28th March outside Cathedral House. Please note the start time is 10.15, not 10.30.

Finally, this Thursday is the beautiful and deeply significant feast of the Annunciation of the Lord. I do hope many people will be able to join us for Mass and/or Vespers for the Annunciation: being a "Solemnity" we start celebrating it liturgically on Wednesday evening 24th with First Vespers at 5pm and Mass at 5.30, and continue on Thursday 25th with Mass at 6.45am, 1.10pm, and 5.30pm, and Second Vespers at 5pm.

May the prayers of Our Lady accompany us all in the week ahead.




Lenten Program for Sydney – Receive the Grace to Go Make
