

WORD FROM THE DEAN



Dear Cathedral Parishioners and Visitors,

Christ is risen! He is truly risen! Alleluia!

We are honoured that St Mary's Cathedral has been chosen by the Holy See as one of the major Marian shrines to participate in the Pope's special rosary during May for an end to the present pandemic.

Each day in May the Rosary will be broadcast from a different important shrine of Our Lady on the Vatican's media platforms, with the Holy Father watching too. St Mary's Cathedral, Sydney has been chosen for Sunday 16th May. On that day, the Archbishop will lead us in praying the Glorious Mysteries of the Rosary in the Cathedral at 6.00pm. As well as the intention of beseeching an end to the pandemic, we have been assigned the further particular prayer intention "For all victims of violence and human trafficking."

Other places chosen to host these Rosaries in May include such famous Basilicas as Lourdes in France, Loreto in Italy, Knock in Ireland, Czestochowa in Poland, Apareceida in Brazil, the Nazareth in Israel, Montserrat in Spain – thirty in all from the different continents.




This weekend is Easter for Orthodox and some Eastern Catholic Churches following the Julian Calendar, so remember to share Paschal joy with your neighbours!
