

Dear Parishioners and Visitors,

The recent Covid infections in Sydney, which have led to a restriction on congregational singing this weekend and a requirement to wear masks inside the cathedral, remind us strongly of the need to pray for an end to this pandemic. There is an added poignancy to our participation in the Pope's "rosary marathon" next Sunday. I hope that many of you will be here at 6.00pm on Sunday 16th May to pray the rosary for that intention and the additional intention assigned to Sydney by the Holy See: for the victims of violence and human trafficking. It has been moving to join in the rosaries streamed online from other Marian shrines so far in May, and we hope to show our beautiful St Mary's Cathedral, and our prayerful community, to the Holy Father and to Catholics around the world next Sunday. Please come and join in.



It is great that they can join us at the 10.30am Mass today for our special commemoration for the end of the Bicentenary of the arrival in Sydney of the first Catholic priests officially appointed to minister in Australia, Father Connolly and Fr Therry. We began this bicentenary last May when the public health orders were much more restrictive. Let's keep praying that we don't have to endure such limitations again.

You will find a small display of objects related especially to Fr Therry, the "founder" of St Mary's, in the Eastern aisle beside the sanctuary.
