WORD FROM THE DEAN



Dear Cathedral Parishioners and Visitors.

The current Covid cluster in Sydney has led to the re-introduction of several measures: face masks must be worn in the cathedral, congregational singing is not permitted, and the one person per 4m² rule applies, so we are limited to 600 persons at Mass for the present time. Please remember to check-in when you enter, using the QR code and Service NSW App.

We continue to pray for an end to this pandemic so that we may return to a healthier amount of family visiting and social interaction. A lot of Sydneysiders have had their holiday travel plans ruined this week, but things could be worse. This past 18 months has been very hard on many people who feel cut off from their loved ones. We pray for the souls of the 910 people who have died from Covid-19 in Australia and over 3,800,000 worldwide so far.

The cathedral's Angelus bell in the Southeast Tower, *Nomen Jesu Christe,* rings five times each day during the pandemic:

9am: Prayer for those infected with COVID-19 and all those who are sick.

12pm: Angelus prayer for health professionals, clergy and all those caring for the sick.

3pm: Prayer for the unemployed, financially stressed, isolated or lonely due to COVID-19.

6pm: Prayer for the people of Australia and especially our political leaders and health authorities.

9pm: Prayer for those who have died from COVID-19 and their families.

You might consider setting reminders on your phone or watch to pray for those same intentions each day.
