WORD FROM THE DEAN



Dear Parishioners and Visitors,

As we continue our journey through the month of November, we continue our prayers for the souls in Purgatory.

Church Tradition has always urged prayer for the deceased, in particular by offering the Eucharistic Celebration for them: it is the best spiritual help that we can give to their souls, particularly to those who are the most forsaken. The foundation of prayer in suffrage lies in the communion of the Mystical Body.

As the Second Vatican Council repeats, “fully conscious of this communion of the whole Mystical Body of Jesus Christ, the pilgrim Church from the very first ages of the Christian religion has cultivated with great piety the memory of the dead” (*Lumen Gentium*, n. 50).

Remembering the dead, caring for their graves and prayers of suffrage, are the testimony of confident hope, rooted in the certainty that death does not have the last word on human existence, for man is destined to a life without limits, which has its roots and its fulfillment in God.” –Pope Francis, Angelus address, **Sunday, 2 November 2014**.

If you wish to have Masses offered for your deceased relations and friends, you can write their names on the special November Mass envelopes available near the doors, and hand the envelopes to the ushers, put them on the collection plate, or drop them in at the Cathedral office during the week.

I would like to reiterate the Archbishop’s message at the Solemn Mass last Sunday about the pressing need to let our Members of Parliament know that we are opposed to the euthanasia Bill currently before the NSW Parliament. Do have a look at www.no euthanasia.org.au to better “know the issues” and to “take action” against this sad development.

On a brighter note, since the cathedral re-opened it has been lovely to see brides, grooms, and their guests in and around the cathedral once again. We have the marriage of some of our parishioners coming up this week, which will be a particular joy – congratulations Carolyn and Richard!
