#### FIRST READING Isaiah 49:3, 5-6

A reading from the prophet Isaiah

I will make you the light of the nations so that my salvation may reach to the ends of the earth.

The Lord said to me, 'You are my servant, Israel, in whom I shall be glorified';

Dear Cathedral Parishioners and Visitors.

The sudden death in Rome of Cardinal Pell has been a true shock. Cardinal Pell was Archbishop of Sydney from March 2001 to February 2014. Cardinal Pell loved St Mary's Cathedral, and always sought to enhance provision for the liturgical, musical and devotional aspects of the cathedral's life, as well as the pastoral. I'm sure many of you know this well and appreciate it. I was Assistant Priest at the Cathedral and became the new Archbishop's Master of Ceremonies when he was transferred here from the See of Melbourne, so I came to know him as a friend as well as a bishop, as did several of the current lay staff at St Mary's, and it has been an emotional week here. It is a privilege, but a very sad one, to be preparing for his funeral and burial at St Mary's Cathedral. Details of time and date are still to be finalized as I write this, and will be notified over the coming days. May his soul and the souls of all the faithful departed rest in peace. Amen.






