All strike their breast thrice, saying




and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man.

Wash thou my wounds in that dear blood Which forth from thee doth flow; New grace, new hope inspire, a new And better heart bestow.




RY For the kingdom, the power and the glo-ry are yours now and for ev-er.


