FIRST READING Isaiah 2:1-5

A reading from the prophet Isaiah

The Lord will gather all nations in eternal peace in the kingdom of God.

The vision of Isaiah son of Amoz, concerning Judah and Jerusalem.

In the days to come
the mountain of the Temple of the Lord
shall tower above the mountains
and be lifted higher than the hills.
All the nations will stream to it,
peoples without number will come to it; and they will say:

'Come, let us go up to the mountain of the Lord, to the Temple of the God of Jacob that he may teach us his ways so that we may walk in his paths; since the Law will go out from Zion, and the oracle of the Lord from Jerusalem.'

GOSPEL Matthew 24:37-44

A reading from the holy Gospel according to Matthew *Stay awake, you must be ready.*

For in those days before the Flood people were eating, drinking, taking wives, taking husbands, right up to the day Noah went into the ark, and they suspected nothing till the Flood came and swept all away. It will be like this when the Son of Man comes. Then of two men in the fields one is taken, one left; of two women at the millstone grinding, one is taken, one left.

'So stay awake, because you do not know the day when your master is coming. You may be quite sure of this that if the householder had known at what time of the night the burglar would come, he would have stayed awake and would not have allowed anyone to break through the wall of his house. Therefore, you too must stand ready because the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect.'

Dear Cathedral Parishioners and Visitors,

Welcome to the season of Advent, a time for new starts and high expectations! Some news about our neighbouring parish, St Patrick's Church, Church Hill:

After 157 years of dedicated service, the Marist Fathers are withdrawing from St Patrick's at the end of this year. Care of St Patrick's Parish will be returning to the clergy of the Archdiocese.

The Archbishop has appointed Fr Lewi Barakat as the next Parish Priest of St Patrick's. Fr Lewi is well known to our Cathedral community, as he was for several years Assistant Priest here and, having recently returned from a period of studies in Rome, is currently resident here at St Mary's. He will take up this important new assignment officially on 1 January.

Fr Lewi will be joined at St Patrick's by Fr Anthony Mifsud, Fr Anderson Rodas and Fr Matthew Lukaszewicz. As Cathedral Administrator I am very glad to have Fr Lewi as my new neighbouring Pastor, and as Dean I look forward to welcoming Frs Anthony, Anderson and Matthew to the City Deanery.

St Patrick's, opened in 1844, is such an important part of the Catholic life of our city, with a busy sacramental ministry of Masses and Confessions, and a rich variety of spiritual and pastoral activities. Its parish covers the northern part of the CBD, the Rocks and Barangaroo, and incorporates the even older St Brigid's in Millers Point.

The Marist Fathers will be greatly be missed at St Patrick's, which is every Sydneysider's "second parish." Do please remember in your prayers the outgoing Parish Priest, Fr Michael Wheelan SM, and his fellow Marists at St Pat's, as they move to their next homes and ministries.






